- 3 P 35. What happened to the people of `Aad ale after they disobeyed Prophet Hud (S)? They were destroyed by a fierce wind that blew on them for seven nights and eight days.
- 3 P 36. To which people was Prophet Saleh صالِح (S) sent?
 To Thamood مُمود, an ancient people living between Arabia and Syria.
- 3 P 37. What did Allah (SWT) give to Prophet Saleh (A) to show that he was a prophet?

 A she-camel that had the ability to know when it was her turns to drink water and when it was the people's turn to drink.
- 3 P 38. What did the people of Thamood ثُمود do to the camel? They slaughtered her.

 The first five verses from Surat Al-'Alaq العَلَّة: "Read, in the name of your Lord, the One who created; He created man from a drop of blood. Read! And your Lord is most bountiful, the One who taught (the use of) the pen; He taught man which he knew not."
- 3 Q 46. What is the Qur'an?
 The Qur'an is the word of Allah (SWT), revealed to the Prophet Mohammed (S) through Angel Gabriel and protected by Allah (SWT) from corruption or loss.
- 3 S 47. Where did the Prophet (S) receive the first revelation? In the cave of Hira in a mountain near Makkah.
- 3 S 48. What is Al-Hijrah الْهِجْرَة ?
 It is the migration of the Prophet (S) from Makkah to Madinah.
- 3 S 49. When did the Prophet (S) migrate?
 Thirteen years after calling the people of Makkah to Islam.
- 3 S 50. What did the Prophet (S) do to earn his living? He was a shepherd and a trader.

For the third time the angel hugged him tightly and said, "Read." And the Prophet (S) answered, "I cannot read." Then the angel recited the first 5 verses of Surat Al-'Alaq
- 3 S 52. How old was the Prophet (S) when Allah's (SWT) message was first revealed to him? He was forty.
- 3 S 53. What was the first word revealed in the Qur'an? Iqra إِقْرَأُ (read)
- 3 S 54. Mention the names of the sons and daughters of the Prophet (S). Al-Qasem بَنْ بَالله , Abdullah إبراهيم , Ibrahim إبراهيم , Ruqayyah وَيُنَّب , Zainab فَالْمِم , Tatimah فَاطِمة , Fatimah فَاطِمة .

 The beginning verses of Surat Al-Muddathir المُدَّثِر , which begins as follows: "O you, who are covered in your cloak, arise and warn, your Lord magnify".
- 3 T 56. What two words does Allah (SWT) use to describe Shaitan in Surat An-Nas النَّاس ?

 Allah described the Shaitan المؤسواس as being Al-Waswas الشيطان and Al-Khannas
- 3 T 57. Name the group of people that Allah (SWT) mentions in Surat Ash-Shams.
 In Surat Ash-Shams, Allah mentions the story of Thamood ثُمود , who were the people of Saleh صالِح (A).
- 3 T 58. In Surat Al-Feel الفيل , what are the stones of sijjeel سِجِيل ? They are small stones made of baked clay.
- 3 T 59. What does the word الْقَارِعَة Al-Qari`ah mean?
 Al-Qari`ah means the striking hour, i.e. the Day of Resurrection.
- 3 T 60. What does Surat Al-Qari`ah القارعة say will happen to us on the Day of Resurrection? It says that people will be judged, and that the one whose balance is heavy will live in Paradise, while the one whose balance is light will end up in Hell.

 Mankind will be like moths scattered and the mountains will be like corded wool.
